Adolescents and adults with neurological impairment, who are medically stable and able to self-administer medication with prompt/cue.

9 a.m. - 3 p.m. Monday thru Friday.

Respite care is available one hour before and after regular program hours.

Pending eligibility, various government programs or private insurance companies may cover program costs. Private pay is also accepted.
