Challengers is a client-directed, social/recreational program designed to provide meaningful activities for persons with physical disabilities. Challengers has a strong emphasis on building interpersonal relationships within a relaxed atmosphere. Activities may include: word puzzles, checkers, cards, bingo, movies, and assorted games.

Participants plan activities, with Case/Program management provided by N.E.W. Curative staff.

ELIGIBILITY

Age 20-55 (discretion of the program director)

Cognitive/intellectual abilities which allow for participation in socialization, group projects, and client-directed programming.

Participants need to be living at home or in a group setting other than a nursing home.

Participants should be medically stable related to ongoing involvement in the program.

Discharge may occur for disruptive behavior, incontinence, or having personal care needs beyond the range of service offered through the program.
