

DISABILITY NAVIGATOR

The Navigator assists people with disabilities to access and navigate the complex program provisions that impact their ability to gain, return to, or retain employment.

The Navigator is not a replacement for a vocational counselor, case manager, or benefit specialist.

The Navigator's primary duties are the following:

- Assist Job Center and Resource Room staff in effectively serving job seekers with disabilities.
- Develop relationships with employers to facilitate job placements for persons with disabilities
- Acquaint employers with the options and resources available to assist them in accommodating employees with disabilities.
- conduct outreach to organizations that serve people with disabilities.
- Facilitate the transition of school age youth with disabilities to the work environment.
- Provide information and training about programs, adaptive technology, and accommodations.
