## ADDITIONAL SERVICES

### OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIES

Alternative Work Program - Alternate jobs for individuals with work-related injuries through the duration of their medical restrictions.

Work Hardening Program - Conditioning program that eases the transition from rehabilitation to work return.

### MCCARRON-DIAL EVALUATION

Identifies strengths and weaknesses in the areas of intellectual, sensory, motor, coping/adaptive behavior, emotional/behavioral/memory functioning in adults with neurological impairments.

### ASSESSMENTS

Individualized assessments conducted at N.E.W Curative or in the community.
