

WORK EMPHASIS PROGRAM

A work-based program providing compensated, non-competitive employment. The goal is to provide a successful work experience, develop appropriate behavior patterns, enhance self-esteem, and attain/maintain the maximum mental and physical capacities of the participant. The program is designed for people with severe disabilities.

EXTENDED EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Program provides transitional, non-competitive, structured employment opportunities to participants. In addition, case management, social services, vocational counseling, and personal adjustment services are provided in order to maximize an individual's vocational potential and assist in transitioning to community employment.

ELIGIBILITY

Brown County residents with diagnoses of a Developmental Disability, Mental Illness, Brain Injury/Neurological Impairment, or AODA.

Both programs can accept clients from other counties.

HOURS & COST

Work Emphasis Program 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Extended Employment Program 6:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Monday thru Friday. Funded by Brown County Human Services Department, and other public sources, pending eligibility.

WORK ADJUSTMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

A treatment/training process utilizing counseling and concurrent work activities to assist individuals in understanding the requirements and demands of work. The program also helps to modify or develop appropriate work habits, attitudes, and behaviors in order to prepare for entry into the competitive job market.

ELIGIBILITY

Persons with disabilities or special employment needs are eligible for program.

HOURS & COST

8:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday.

Pending eligibility, fees can be covered by various governmental or private funding sources, including: Wisconsin Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR), Worker's Compensation, insurance companies, etc.

Individual program fees can also be developed.
